The Virginia Chamber of Commerce's 2018 Legislative Report Card grades members of the Virginia General Assembly on their voting record on key business issues, reporting legislators' support for initiatives that will spur long-term economic growth and their willingness to stand up against legislation that would harm our business climate.

In December of 2017, the Virginia Chamber released *Blueprint Virginia 2025*, a comprehensive plan of action to ensure the Commonwealth strengthens and secures its position as a leader in the global economy and is the best state for business. *Blueprint Virginia 2025* serves as the Virginia Chamber's legislative agenda.

Each year, pending legislation is evaluated based on its consistency with the goals in *Blueprint Virginia 2025*. During the 2018 session, the Virginia Chamber tracked **more than 600 bills** and took a position on over **160 key bills**. With the help of Virginia's pro-business legislators, we achieved a **92% success rate** on our legislative priorities during the 2018 session, saving Virginia employers **\$6.4 billion**.

GRADING CRITERIA

The value of each vote was determined by dividing 100 by the total number of bills. If a legislator did not vote on a bill and did not have an excused absence that day, they were docked half of one vote's value. Since legislators abstain from voting in cases of an ethical conflict, if a legislator abstained from a vote, this was not counted against them. Bonus points were given for being a Patron (+2 points) or Chief Co-Patron (+1.5 points) of a Blueprint priority bill, with a maximum score of 100. Points were docked for being a Patron (-2 points) or Chief Co-Patron (-1.5 points) of a bill that would have increased the cost of doing business in Virginia.
