


Do you feel Virginia's economy is going in the right direction, or do you feel Virginia's economy is off on the wrong track?





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
Do you feel the country's economy is going in the right direction, or do you feel the country's economy is off on the wrong track?








If the election for President were held today and you had to make a choice, for whom would you vote...




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As you may know, Virginia is currently a "Right to Work" state, meaning it protects workers from being forced to join a union as a condition of employment.

Do you support or oppose Virginia's Right to Work law?






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This November, there is a possible amendment to the Virginia state constitution, which would make the state's Right to Work law a part of the state constitution.

If the election was held today, would you vote for or against making Virginia's Right to Work law a part of the state constitution?



Do you support or oppose building the Atlantic Coast Pipeline project through Virginia?





Do you support or oppose the Washington Redskins moving to a stadium in Virginia after their lease expires at Fed Ex Field?



Do you support or oppose tax dollars being used to incentivize the Washington Redskins to move to a new stadium in Virginia?


